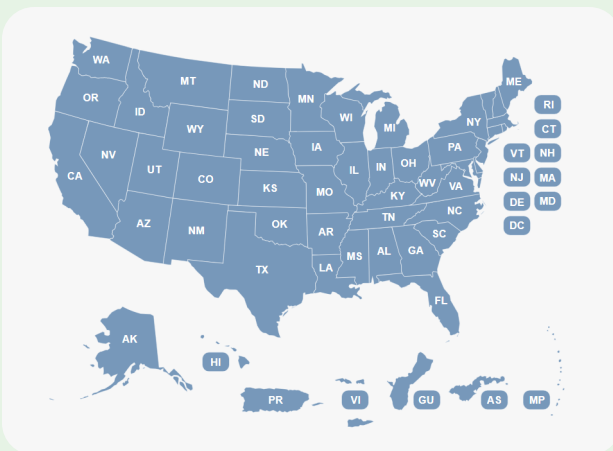

Accessing State Specific Public Benefits

Public benefits are typically state specific. Begin by navigating to your state's official human services or social services department to find programs, eligibility, and how to apply. Or to find the links to specific state programs, visit [NIWP State Public Benefits Map](#). To use:



- Click on the state of interest.
- Scroll down to the state section.
- Click on the first link, the [State] **Screening** Chart (not the Full Public Benefits Chart).
- Click on the PDF link.
- Scroll down to the chart.
- Find relevant programs and click the link to the relevant benefit website.
